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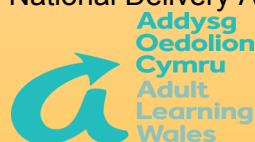
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# Certificate in Youth Work Practice — Level 3

## 1. Target Audience

The Certificate in Youth Work is targeted at learners, wishing to lead in a youth work setting

Full - and part-time youth workers  
Volunteer youth workers

## Entry requirements for learners:

- 18 years of age to undertake the qualification
- Working with young people or have a placement in a youth work setting
- Have a current DBS or undertake a DBS check on enrolment
- **Have completed the Award in Youth Work Practice Level 2**
- Have enrolled with EWS as Support Worker

## 2. Purpose of the Qualification

This qualification will prepare learners to **lead** work with young people in a range of youth work settings.

**Please note:** From April 2017 it is a legal requirement that on completion of the Award in Youth Work Practice L2 and Certificate in Youth Work Practice Level 3 you are **legally required to register as a Support Youth Worker with Education Workforce Council (EWC) Wales.**

## 3. Achieving the Certificate

The Level 3 Certificate in Youth Work is composed of 4 mandatory units and 1 optional unit  
To achieve the Certificate, the learner must achieve all units.  
Learners must complete all units within two years of registration.

## 4. Assessment Requirements

Learners must complete a range of tasks outlined in their Certificate in Youth Work Practice L3 portfolio.  
The learner will spend up to 60 hours on placement activities

## 5. Placement Requirements

Before the placement is commenced a current DBS is required, and a signed Placement Agreement Form must be submitted, signed supervisor/line manager who is qualified at level 4 or above.

The placement learning can be achieved by working in a youth club or other youth organisation for a few hours a week or for a block period. However it is required that the placement learning covers a sufficient period of time for the learner to develop relationships with the young people and extend and review their practice and professional development.

## 6. Course costs

This is an Addysg Oedolion Cymru | Adult Learning Wales funded course and so course costs will be subsidised by organisations that have a service level agreement in place for 2017—18.

**Please note that learners must complete all tasks and submit portfolio. Failure to do so will result in a charge to the learner.**
